AHEM Rushes to Stephen Colbert's Aid

BEDMINSTER, New Jersey (June 25, 2013) - In an effort to help political pundit and talk show host Stephen Colbert secure his rightful place in the history books as a great founding father, the Anti Human Extinction Movement (AHEM) rushed to Colbert's aid Tuesday and offered him the opportunity to be among the first to sign [AHEM's Declaration of Interdependence](#), which is launching July 4, 2013.

With the launch of AHEM's Declaration of Interdependence only eight days away, AHEM's leadership team knew they had to act fast. They reached out to Colbert on Tuesday with a [video](#), [open letter](#), and [hashtag](#) (#HeyColbert) to match. They offered the pundit the chance to be one of the original signatories to AHEM's Declaration of Interdependence so that he can avoid the potentially massive public outrage and shaming that might occur. Should Colbert respond ([via @intrrptevrythng](#)), AHEM's team is prepared to give him a preview of the Declaration, a prime signature location, and an opportunity to add his John Hancock before the Declaration opens to the public on July 4, 2013. With the clock counting down, the one question everyone is asking is whether or not Colbert will respond in time to let AHEM help him help himself.
